- Follow directions when using paint, garden and cleaning products – to protect ourselves and the environment.

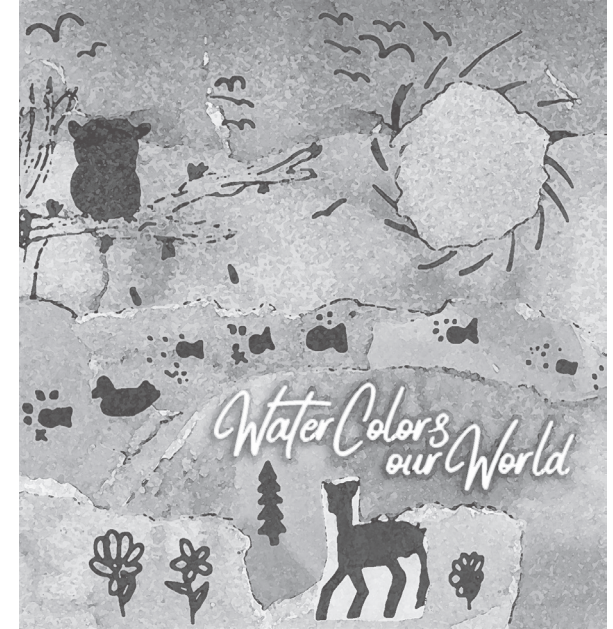

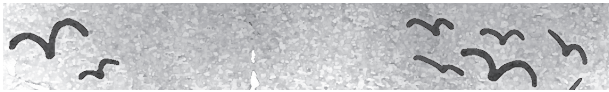
